
Basic Feltie Tutorial:

The following items are needed in order to complete a large padded feltie.

- 1. Embroidery machine and the ability to transfer your design to the machine.
- 2. The vinyl or felt you wish to use for your feltie
- 3. Embroidery thread
- 4. Cutaway stabilizer
- 5. Quilt batting

STEP 1. Move your design to your machine and get it set up as you wish and prepare your hoop with your stabilizer. Once you are ready to start stitching, step 1 is the placement stitch. This is going to tell you where to place your vinyl/felt which you will use for the feltie. Please note – The color that shows the most on your design will be your base color. Then you will stitch as an applique as if the base color is your shirt. **STOP** YOUR MACHINE AFTER THIS STEP



STEP 2. After the placement stitch is down take your vinyl/felt that you are going to use for your feltie and your quilt batting and place it over the placement stitch face up. **STOP** YOUR MACHINE AFTER THIS STEP.


STEP 3: You will now start appliquing the piece on your base fabric for your feltie. This is what is going to hold he base vinyl/fabric down.



STEP 4. Once you have all the pieces appliqued on with the tack down stitch the design will the complete all the satin steps for the design. Once all the satin stitching is complete and **BEFORE** final step remove your hoop.



STEP 5: Once you have your hoop removed you will then place the vinyl/felt you are using for your back onto the back of the hoop. You want the front facing down. This will cover all your stitching.





Step 6: You will then place your hoop back on your hoop and stitch your final stitch which will attach the front and back together. Once you have the final step stitched, you will remove from your hoop and trim.
