

Online CEU Policy

Texas Chiropractic College (TCC) Sponsorship

Whole Food Practice partners with Texas Chiropractic College to provide online CEU programming for Chiropractors and TCC has an automatic approval agreement with 25 states, as well as an additional 9 states if adequate advance notice is given for specific state board approvals (see next section). We cannot guarantee the acceptance of these credit courses for chiropractors in outlying states or other healthcare profession licensing. It is up to each practitioner expecting to use these CEU courses for relicensing to know and understand their state's by-laws and to confirm course acceptance by their state examining board.

Approved States for Chiropractors

The following states provide automatic, online CEU credit approval for Texas Chiropractic College sponsored programs: Colorado (CO), Connecticut (CT), District of Columbia (DC), Delaware (DE), Idaho (ID), Illinois (IL), Indiana (IN), Iowa (IA), Maryland (MD), Massachusetts (MA), Michigan (MI), Mississippi (MS), Montana (MT), Nebraska (NE), New Jersey (NJ), North Dakota (ND), Ohio (OH), Oregon (OR), Rhode Island (RI), South Carolina (SC), Utah (UT), Vermont (VT), Virginia (VA), Washington (WA), Wyoming (WY).

We may also receive approval from the following states: Alaska (AK), Kansas (KS), Maine (ME), Minnesota (MN), Nevada (NV), New Mexico (NM), North Carolina (NC), South Dakota (SD).

Other states may still allow our eLearning CEU courses, however, there are often additional course submissions, fees and waiting periods. We will update this policy as we navigate the topic of online CEU approvals. Applied Clinical Nutrition (ACN) Enrollees

Applied Clinical Nutrition (ACN) certificate enrollees may use **any** CEU eLearning courses from the Whole Food Practice website toward their continuing education seminar requirements for certification and will receive an immediate CEU voucher upon successful completion. They may also submit any online nutrition CEU programs that are sponsored by an accredited chiropractic college or online PDA programs sponsored by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM).

Nutritional Clinical Assistant (NCA) Enrollees

Nutritional Clinical Assistant (NCA) Level II certification enrollees may use any eLearning courses from the Whole Food Practice website or local seminars toward their electives. NCA Level I certificate enrollees do not have any seminar requirements. NCA enrollees are not licensed health care practitioners and should register for seminars or webinars as participants, not as practitioners requesting CEUs.
